GET TO KNOW YOUR UNIVERSITY

KNOW WHO CAN HELP YOU

In your center

Your Faculty or School is headed by a team of professors headed by the **Dean** (Faculty) or **Director** (School). Each member of the team has different responsibilities, but there will always be a Deputy Dean or Assistant Principal who deals with issues that affect students.

If any doubts shall arise regarding your enrollment or academic record, the **Secretariat** of your center will be your reference to solve them.

You can go to the **Concierge** (located at the entrance of the building) to ask for the location of any classroom, laboratory or service offered by your Center.

Near the entrance you will find the **promoter** of your Center, a student like you, to whom you can consult any doubts about the services and activities of the Center itself. They will also guide you on how to access the other services offered by the University.

In addition, you can find help in the **Student Delegation**, where you will be able to locate the representatives of the students of your Center.

Within the framework of the **Guidance and Tutorial Action Plan (POAT)**, most of the Centers have a mentor student program (to accompany you during the first courses) and tutors (who will advise you during your studies). It is usually the Vice-Dean or Assistant Principal who deal with the students who coordinate the POAT.

In addition, your Center has a website with relevant information that we advise you to visit.

In the Vice-Rector for Students

The US government team is composed of the Rector and a team of Vice-rectors, of whom one is in charge of all matters that concern the student. The Vice-Rectorate of Students has its headquarters in the semi-basement floor of the Pavilion of Brazil (Paseo de las Delicias, s / n).

Here you can find information regarding course offerings, access to various **official degrees**, **MECD scholarships and scholarships** from the University, the management of degrees or any other query related to your passage through the US.

In the CADUS

The Student Council of the University (CADUS) is the highest body of student representation and is composed of all the Student Delegations of the Centers. Its mission is to look after the interests of students within the University as well as before other autonomous or state bodies. You can address the delegates of the CADUS in the Pavilion of Uruguay (Avda. De Chile, s / n)

In the Central Services

Many professionals in the US work so that you can have everything you need: a complete catalog of books and publications to support your studies (Library), accommodation and university dining halls with healthy menus at affordable prices (University Community Assistance Service -SACU-), 24-hour study rooms (Vice-Rectorate for Students), internships (Business and Employment Practices Service -SPEE-), national and international mobility grants (International Center), a wide cultural offering (Cultural Initiatives -CICUS-), recreation (Sports Activities Service -SADUS-), information about the activities organized in the US (News Bulletin -BINUS-) and many other services that you will find more detailed in the Student Guide (Guiadeestudiantes.us.es) or by consulting the directory of services on the US portal (us.es/about/directory)

If any doubts shall arise, you can contact the Center of Attention to Students from any place at any time. Experts from the US will generally answer your queries within a maximum period of 48 hours.

To change your password and / or know your virtual user (UVUS) consult how to do it in the following web address:

Or go to a computer lab in any University Center or Campus, or go to the SOS Service of Students, located in Avda. Reina Mercedes, Edificio Rojo, from 8:00 to 15:00 and from 17:00 to 20:00, remembering to bring your ID card.

Personal Information Management Service (GIP)

Webmail. Use your institutional email (uvus@alum.us.es). Virtual agenda. Record your events in the electronic calendar. Virtual disk. Up to 1 GB of storage on US servers.

sevius.us.es Virtual Secretary (SEVIUS)

In SEVIUS you can consult: your personal data and update your contact details, your registration data and obtain proof of enrollment, consult your transcript, academic records, the calendar of exams, consult your scholarship application and its current status, The results of your entrance exam carried out at the University of Seville, your academic credit for the following semester, consult tutoring hours and receive notifications. You can also apply for your University Card and follow the process of issuing it.

Virtual Teaching Platform

Download the Blackboard Student app on your mobile device ... and activate the option to receive alerts!

The Virtual Teaching platform of the University of Seville is designed to support face-to-face teaching through technological resources of online training. These means facilitate the access of students to the contents and training materials of various teaching methods at any time and regardless of where they are.

Note that not all of the subjects you have enrolled in have to appear on your "course list", as it depends on whether they have been registered by the professor on the platform.

User **profile of the University of Seville** where you can consult your personal data, the data of your university email, enter additional data or change the password of your US Virtual User (and thus, of all related applications: mail, virtual secretariat, virtual teaching, wireless network of The US, etc.).

You will be able to print documents in the different copy shops located in each campus of the University of Seville. The files sent to Webprint are available for a week, during which time you can go to any copy shop listed in the section 'Centros de Reprografía' (Print Centers) and print your document easily.

Access to the US (ReInUS) and Eduroam WIFI Network

Given that the University of Seville is part of the Eduroam network, users of the network, in addition to accessing the US Wi-Fi network, can access the wireless networks of other Eduroam organizations (most universities and Research centers of Spain and many other foreign countries), using its UVUS. The first time you go to connect you must configure your device or mobile device following the directions you find in the following URL: *eduroam.us.es* For the following connections, the configuration will be saved and you only have to indicate your username and password (UVUS).

At the US Headquarters you can access procedures and services for students; Of special interest to you may be the possibility to request scholarships and aid, to present an application by online registration or to request a loan of a bicycle. Please note that for some of these procedures you will need to identify yourself with your UVUS and for others you will need your digital certificate or electronic ID.

The Certificate of the University of Seville is a smart card that accredits you as a member of the University Community. It contains a chip where your informational data is stored, protected by a secret code (PIN) that only you know.



How do I get it?

The route to follow within SEVIUS is My profile> University card.

What is it for?

As a library card. In order to check out books, you will have to identify yourself with your card at the library desk or at the self-loan terminals. You can also borrow a laptop.

- To access the computer labs of the university centers. In some of them, computers have chip card readers and an access program that will require the PIN of your card so that you can use it.
- To access the Sports Activities Service of the University of Seville (SADUS). If you subscribe to the SADUS, your card will be required to enter the facilities.
- Next to the entrance door of the Study Rooms, you will find card readers that will allow you access to them outside the general operationg hours.
- Also, there are card readers that will allow you to open gates to parking lots and doors of areas reserved for motorcycles and bicycles. (Please note that some car parks require authorization).

In addition, with your card you can use the University Information Points (P.I.U.), which are electronic consultation terminals located in the University Centers, which allow you to carry out consultation operations through SEVIUS. You can also place your digital signature on your card and you can use it to identify yourself in companies that make special offers to students of the university.

GET YOUR FIRST OPTIONAL CREDIT AT UNIVERSITY! When?

You can take the course any time you want, from October to June.

How?

From the virtual teaching platform, with your virtual User of the US. You can download all the materials in your computer at any time on the course website. bib.us.es/cursos_orientacion

Where?

Anywhere! You only need to have a computer with Internet access to enter the platform of the University of Seville. Click on virtual teaching (ev.us.es) to access it.

What will I learn?

- The most effective study techniques.
- The computer services offered by the University of Seville: how to access them, software available, resources you can find on the net, and how to acquire your digital identity.
- In addition, you will learn to find and locate useful information for your classwork, to evaluate it and avoid plagiarism, citing sources and establishing "your privacy" on the network. The Library will have no secrets for you.

How do I get my ECTS credit for the Study Guidance Course?

New students entering undergraduate degrees who have passed the COE course and conducted the satisfaction survey will receive a message in mid-July and, from September, will be able to pick up their accreditation, and if they so wish, apply their credit to their degree. TRAINING

In order to offer students complementary training to their degrees, the University of Seville calls for grants to carry out training in their Central Services (to qualify for these grants, it is necessary that you will have surpassed at least 25% of the credits of your Curriculum).



• MOBILITY

Mobility grants allow you to take part of your studies in another Spanish or foreign university or to practice in other countries through an agreement.

• CULTURAL AND SPORTS

The purpose of these grants is to encourage the development of cultural initiatives and support the performance of recreational activities.



AWARDS AND DISTINCTIONS

The University of Seville, with the purpose of recognizing and encouraging excellence in the study of its students, grants a series of awards and distinctions, such as the extraordinary prizes for the end of your undergarduate or doctorate degrees or prizes for the best admission scores, along with others.

Accreditation of at least a B1 level of a foreign language is essential for graduation. If you are not accredited at the end of your studies, you will not be able to obtain your degree. To accredit your level in a foreign language, it will be necessary that you present your certificate at the Institute of Languages (IDI). If you do not have it, you will be able to take the courses taught at IDI or perform your accreditation tests. You have to plan ahead of time; it is advisable that you get your accreditation as soon as possible.

STUDY SUPPORT SERVICES

University Library

The library of the University of Seville has seventeen service points distributed across the different campuses and has a large amount of resources for study, including:

- Access to its **bibliographic collection** (with more than 2,000,000 books and 30,000 journals in printed or digital form) through the Fama catalog (*fama.us.es*).
- Loan of up to 7 documents (books, dvd, laptops, e-books, magazines, etc ...) with possibility of renewal and / or reservation.
- Information, orientation and courses to learn how to manage information and bibliographic resources.
- Group work reservation.

Many of these services are offered virtually and all of them are offered in person, hours from Monday to Friday from 8 a.m. to 9 p.m. In addition, every Saturday, a Library will open from 9 a.m. to 9 p.m. (in evaluation periods, five libraries will be open).

It encourages the "Encounter" between Spanish and foreign university students by practicing languages and / or expanding knowledge about the language, society and culture of other countries.

WORK PLACEMENT IN COMPANIES

The objective of the Secretariat of Internship in Business and Employment is to facilitate the connection between the students of the US, of both Undergraduate and Master, and recent graduates with the world of work. You can perform:

Curricular Practices

Offered by your Center. You must be enrolled in the subject of external practices that is part of the curriculum of your degree. More information in: Vicedean / Sub-Directorate of Practices of your Center.

Extracurricular Internships

Offered by companies and institutions. They are not part of your curriculum. You can do them voluntarily during your studies if you have exceeded 50% of the credits needed to obtain the degree you are studying and you must be enrolled in your degree during the internship.

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
